## Internet & Public Computer Use Policy

The Library provides **free public access** to the Internet and public computers as an informational, educational and recreational resource for all community members.

- The Library is not liable for content on the Internet
  - Parents and guardians have the responsibility for deciding which resources are appropriate for their children. They also have the right to revoke internet privileges for minors (18 and younger)
- Use of the Internet and public computers is at the risk of the user
- Patrons must use their own Library card when logging on to public computers
  - Using another patron's card is prohibited
    - Children accompanied by guardian may use guardian's library card
- The Library reserves the right to monitor and/or disconnected patrons from public computers or wi-fi if use if:
  - disrupting other patrons' use of the library or disrupting library services
  - inappropriate sites have been accessed
  - exposing minors to explicit content
  - exposing minor to harmful materials as outlined in [WI Statute 948.11](#)
- The Library reserves the right to revoke a patron's Library card based on misrepresentation or repeat Internet and Public Computer Use Policy offenses
- Internet computer use may be interrupted after one hour if there is a waiting line for a workstation. If this occurs, patrons may make a reservation to return to a workstation
- Guest passes may be issued for out-of-state residents or visitors
